\$5362

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, Mathematics and Science from 50% in Prep–4 (2017) to 80% in P-5 (2019)
- Increase NAPLAN results (reading, writing) to 50 % Upper 2 Bands (U2B) for Years 3 and 5
- Ensure Year 3 and 5 students reach National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Literacy, Numeracy and Writing.
- Facilitate every student accessing a year level curriculum (that is, with an individual improvement plan) to achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year level achievement standard
- Increase Prep – Year 2 reading results Progress for Meaning (PM) to 100% at or above Regional Benchmarks.
- Improve teacher and teacher aide capabilities in Reading through professional development and focused feedback to achieve improved student outcomes.


